The Memphis Challenge: 35 Years of History and Impact

In 1989, Joseph R. "Pitt" Hyde, a visionary business leader and philanthropist, founded The Memphis Challenge, a high school program that began with 20 seniors from East High School. Dr. Tom Eppley led the program, which started in AutoZone, to create a learning experience supporting the growth and development of high-achieving students in the city. The program also aimed to expose these students to colleges and universities across the United States. In 2003, under the leadership of Cassandra H. Webster, the program expanded to include junior high school students recruited from Memphis and Shelby County schools. This expansion increased the number of students served from 20 to over 50. The program aimed to enhance students' social and emotional capital, positioning them as highly sought-after diverse talent. The core workshops were designed to catapult students and empower them with tools and networks to thrive in colleges and universities across the United States. In the summer, Challengers return to Memphis to paid summer internships at businesses, companies, and non-profits to gain experience and the opportunity to gain full-time employment once they finish college.

The 9/10 Movement, launched in the summer of 2014, has profoundly impacted ninth and tenth-grade students. This initiative aims to provide these students with the social and emotional skills needed for academic success and community leadership. Its growth from 50 to 130 students and participants from 10 to 35 high schools demonstrates the program's success. Additionally, more than 40 percent of students continue the program through their senior years. Our ability to mentor, coach, nurture, and develop Challengers during this critical phase in their growth trajectory demonstrates its effectiveness and the significant impact on our students.



In January 2016, the Tell Me A Story arts immersion experience was launched to provide students with art therapy. The goal was to support student mental health by using creative expression to explore feelings and self-awareness. Throughout this learning journey, the Challengers have engaged in various creative activities such as writing children's storybooks, sculpting their hands, creating digital zines, short films, and spoken word performances. Each year, the Challengers decide what form of art to explore. The students' dedication to their art projects is awe-inspiring, with many devoting hours and weekends to their creations. The projects have been exhibited at notable venues such as FedEx World Headquarters, Hattiloo Theatre, and Baptist Hospital. The upcoming installment, Tell Me A Story: "What Keeps Me Up At Night," will involve creating quilt squares, encouraging students to explore their struggles and sources of comfort, similar to traditional quilts that reflect the stories of their makers. Through this project, students engage in a historic and culturally significant art form and contribute to a collaborative piece that reflects their shared experiences and resilience.

The Memphis Challenge has seen 54 percent of its alumni choosing to live and work in Memphis, directly contributing to the local economy and community development. Our strategic partnerships support these outcomes by providing participants with internships, job opportunities, mentorship, and additional resources to enhance their personal and professional growth. Our alumni have pursued careers in various fields, including arts and culture, business, finance, education, entrepreneurship, nonprofit leadership, healthcare, law, and politics. This diversity of careers makes The Memphis Challenge proud to have alumni in each profession.


